

RESOLUTION NO. 2 OF 2021

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NANTICOKE
FILLING THE VACANCY OF COUNCILMEMBER JOHN PIETRZYK**

WHEREAS, the Council seat of John Pietrzyk is now vacant due to his unexpected passing on January 2, 2021;

WHEREAS, Section 2.09 of the City of Nanticoke Home Rule Charter provides that in the event of a vacancy in the Office of a City Council Member, the City Council shall, by a majority vote of the total number of City Council Members, which shall be 3 affirmative votes, fill the vacancy;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to fill this vacancy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Nanticoke and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same as follows:

1. The City Council of the City of Nanticoke hereby votes to confirm **Joseph H. Nalepa**, to fill the vacant Council seat left by virtue of the unexpected passing of Councilmember John Pietrzyk on January 2, 2021. This appointment shall take effect immediately and shall be effective through the next municipal election at which time the unexpired term, if any, shall be filled by the electors of the City of Nanticoke.
